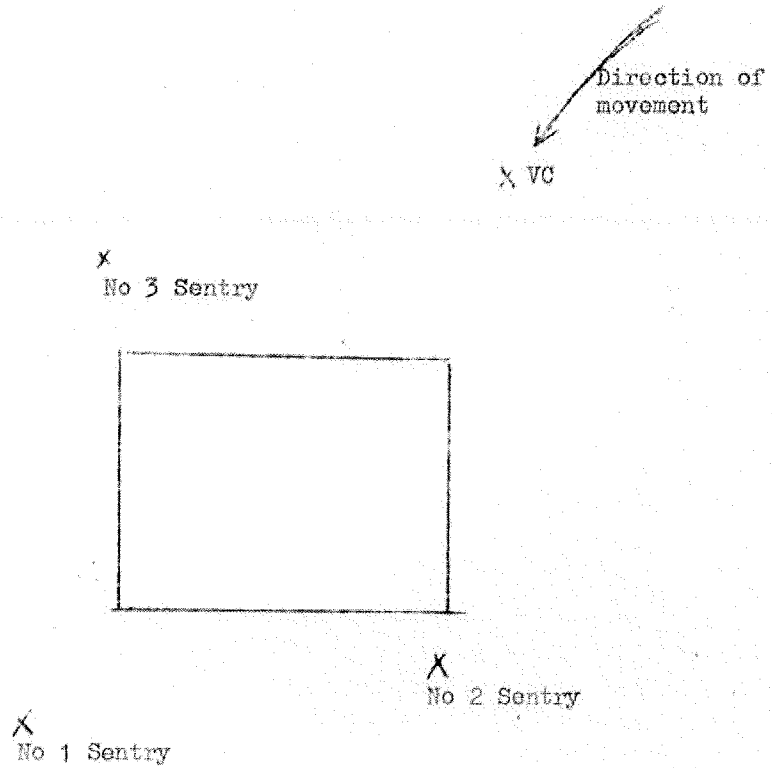

REPORT OF CONTACT 031925 Feb 70



Enemy approached and sighted by sentry No 2 . Sentry No 2 was waiting until on in claymore area. En saw sentry No 3 setting up claymore. En fired at Sentry No 3 who fired back. Sweep in the morning revealed the body.

It is assumed, as no wpn was located, that a second VC fired the shots.

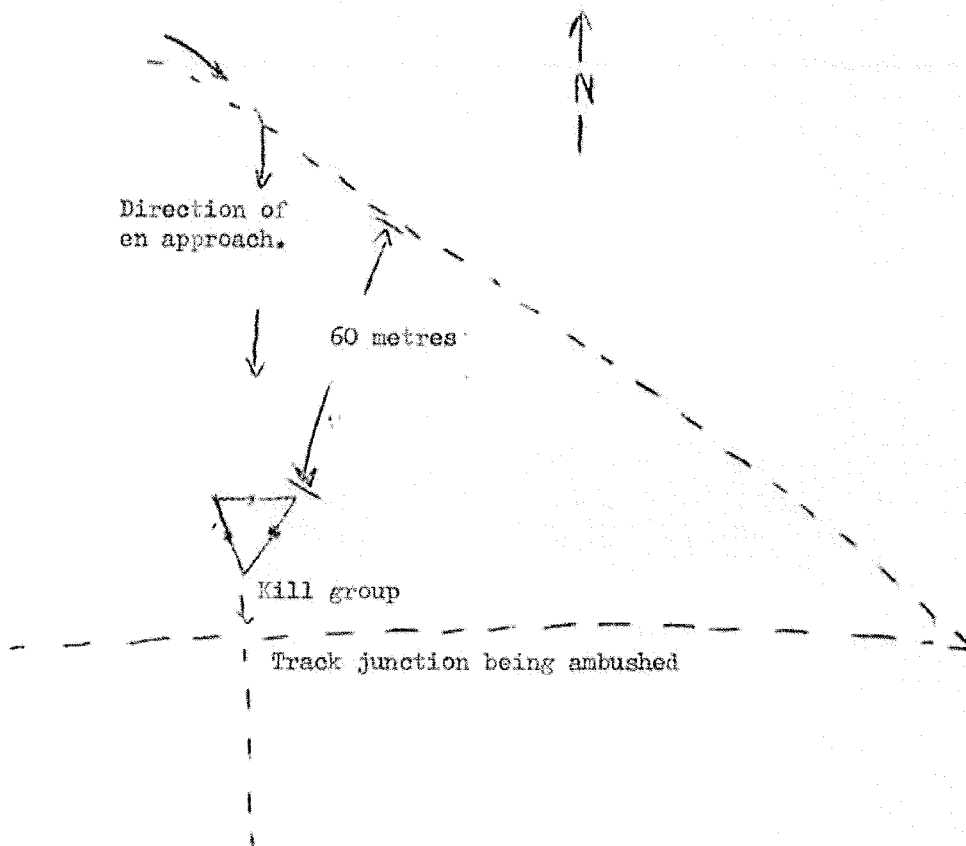

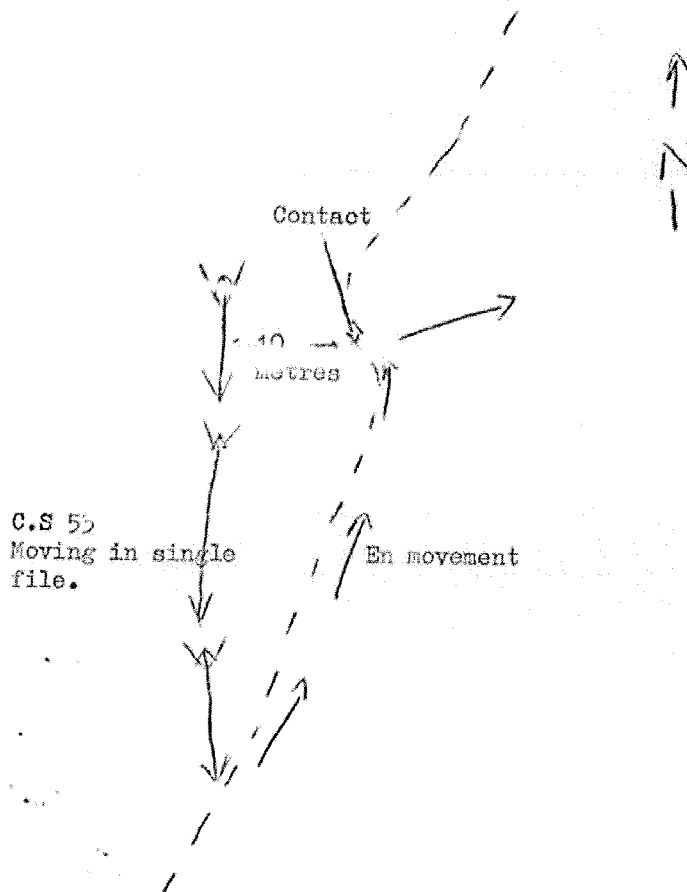

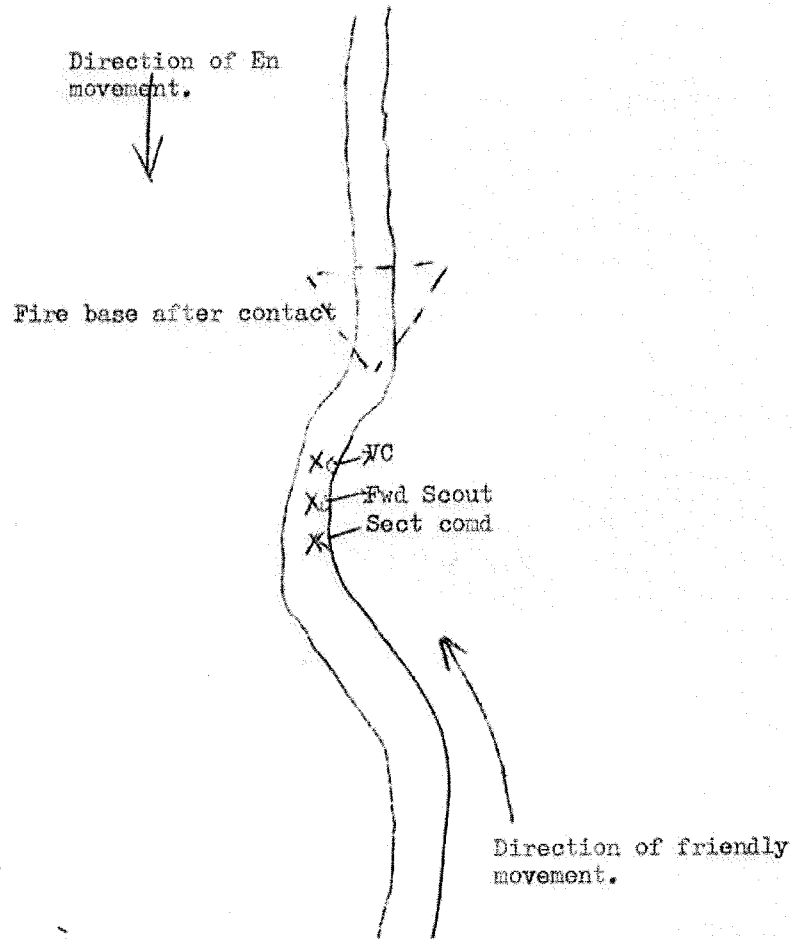
