
Thank you for your email that was received by your Case Manager Rob Todman on 17 February 2015 concerning entitlements under the Veterans' Support Act 2014.

Under ordinary circumstances, providing that a veteran continues to suffer from all of his or her disabilities that were accepted under the War Pensions Act 1954 and treatment and/or rehabilitation does not significantly improve or lessen the veterans level of impairment, any veteran transferring from a War Disablement Pension to a Disablement Pension will retain that pension for the remainder of their life as per Scheme One of the Veterans' Support Act 2014.

However, if a veteran were to be imprisoned, he or she loses all entitlements under Parts 3, 4 and 5 of the Veterans' Support Act 2014 during the period of his or her imprisonment.
